This notice announces a 15-day comment period in which **the public may comment on the modifications to the originally proposed text** for the sexually violent predator evaluation processes regulation. This notice is issued pursuant to Government Code section 11346.8, subsection (c), California Code of Regulations, title 1, section 44, and Government Code section 11347.1.

No action by the public is necessary unless persons wish to comment on the proposed modified text.

SUMMARY OF THE PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS

The proposed adoption of new text and sections in the 45-day notice were released on November 17, 2017 and are shown in plain text. The 15-day proposed modifications are shown in <u>single underline</u> to indicate additions and single strikeout to indicate deletions from the originally proposed regulatory text.

The following 15-day modifications were made to the Regulation Text:

- 1. In Section 4020.1, subdivision (b) was eliminated and clarified in section 4020.1, subdivision (a)(1).
- 2. In Section 4020.1, subdivisions (a)(1) was added and (a)(2) was modified, to clarify when independent evaluators will be appointed for a difference of opinion.

In addition to the modifications described above, additional modifications correcting grammar, changes in numbering and formatting have been made to improve clarity. These changes are nonsubstantive.
